Kevin Newbury is a theatre and opera director based in New York City. Recent opera credits include Bernstein's *MASS* (**Carnegie Hall, United Palace, Baltimore Symphony, Kennedy Center**), *Falstaff* (**Santa Fe Opera**), *Il barbiere di Siviglia*, *Le nozze di Figaro*, and *Il Trovatore* (**Minnesota Opera**), *Die Zauberflöte* (**Opera Colorado, Houston Grand Opera**), and *Nixon in China* (Revival Director: **Chicago Opera Theatre, Portland Opera, Cincinnati Opera**).

Recent New York theatre credits include: *Candy and Dorothy* (GLAAD Media Award Winner, Drama Desk Nominee, also at Wellfleet Harbor Actor's Theatre in Cape Cod), *The Black Monk*, *The Second Tosca*, *Kiss and Cry* (GLAAD Nominee), *The Eumenides*, the Lincoln Center Theatre Director's Lab and concerts at Joe's Pub, Birdland, Ars Nova and the Weill Recital Hall.

Upcoming opera projects include: *Roberto Devereux*, *Anna Bolena*, and *Maria Stuarda* (**Minnesota Opera**), *La cenerentola* (**Glimmerglass Opera**), *Eugene Onegin* (**Opera Theatre of St. Louis**), Rota's *Il cappello di paglia di Firenze* (**Wexford Opera Festival**), Bernstein: *MASS* (European Tour with **Absolute Ensemble**), *La bohème* (**Wolf Trap Opera**), and the world premiere of Lewis Spratlan's Pulitzer Prize-winning *Life is a Dream* (**Santa Fe Opera**). Kevin is also in pre-production for a film adaptation of David Johnston's *Mothra is Waiting*.

Kevin has been a champion of new plays throughout his career. Four new plays that Kevin developed and directed in production were subsequently published, and he has directed dozens of readings and workshops for companies including the New Group, Rattlestick Playwright's Theatre, Young Playwrights, Inc., and the Ensemble Studio Theatre. Education projects include productions for NYU's MFA Playwrighting Program, the Atlantic Theatre School, the Santa Fe Opera Apprentice Program and a multi-media education project for Opera Theatre of St. Louis.
